





Lake Garnett has been the scene of some of the most exciting sports car racing in the country. Many great names have raced on its surface.


In 1961, Harry Heuer brought down his Meister Brouser Racing Team from Chicago and took all honors. He returned the following year with Jim Hall, both in Chapparals, but they took a back seat to the very fast Cooper Monaco ably driven by Alan Connell.

In 1963, Carroll Shelby took the opportunity to score a big win over the Corvettes. Race fans remember when he hauled his team of Ford powered Cobras from California to do battle with the popular Sting Rays of the Grady Davis Racing Team from Pennsylvania. Ken Miles won the race going away.

In 1964, Jack Hinkel, of Wichita, won the big race in his Cooper Monaco. This was the first win at Garnett since 1960 when Jack had won the big event two years in a row.

In 1968, Brad Brooker took his Shelby GT-350 to the winner's circle and in 1969, the last year of the Grand Prix, racers came from both coasts to "race Garnett." Roy Woods, Jr., ran a Camaro Z-28 and a Formula Ford that year and Mark Waco raced a Formula Ford. Neither won that year but both have done well since that time in SCCA's professional Trans-Am Series. That year, Don Yenko took it all in a very fast Corvette.








WOODY WOODWARD after drive into lake

# The Four Types of Race Cars Seen At Lake Garnett




#### PRODUCTION CARS

Mass produced sports cars running from a Corvette to a Sprite. These cars bear close resemblance in appearance to showroom cars but are permitted some modification and special parts.

#### SEDANS

Mass produced compact sedans with the general requirement that they were originally designed to carry passengers in the rear seat.






#### FORMULA CARS

These are open wheel racing machines similar to but slightly different than the Indy or Grand Prix cars. Engines vary by class and range from 5 liter engines to a Volkswagen engine with a 1600 cc Ford Cortina engine in between.


#### SPORTS RACING CARS

Unlimited sports cars that compete according to engine size. They have two seats and four fenders but are very stack in fittings. This class probably offers the best opportunity in racing for individual ingenuity in auto design.

# Everything You Always Wanted To Know About Sports Car Spectatoring . . . hut were afraid to ask. by Bob Severs

Dr. Vicarious gives frank, straight-from-the-shoulder answers to ever the most intimate of your spectatoring questions.

1. Why do all the cars have funny numbers and letters on them?

The number identifies the car and driver. No two cars in the same race will have the same number. The letters, however, indicate the class in which the carraces. Classes range from A to H with A being the potentially faster cars. Cars of equal performance capabilities are assigned to the same class. Following the class designation letter will be either a "P" for production (stock), an "SR" for sports racing, and an "F" for Formula car (one without fenders). GP therefore means class "G", production - not "parental guidance suggested" as in the movies.

2. Why do winners always say the track was fine, but losers say it was rough and slippery with oil?

Because winners are winners and losers are losers. Who needs an excuse for winning.

3. How come sports cars race on road courses?

You will find an occasional race on the ovals but like the origin of the car themselves, racing started through the streets of Europe, . thus road racing, Enthusiasts also maintain that a road course is a better test of both man and machine. Some cars go fast on the straight and not so fast through the turns. Other cars are just the opposite. It makes for interesting racing.

4. Have they ever held a Demolition Derby on a road course with sports cars?

Yes, many times, but they always started out to be regular races and really weren't planned that way.

5. Is a good cornering technique vital to winning races? Keep an eye out for two cars that are running together. If one driver seems to be working pretty hard - you know, letting it hand out on every corner - while the other just quietly keeps up, but on the smooth one. The "Hollywood"

approach is not only hard on the car, but the margin of error is almost nonexistent. The tire-squealing hot dog will almost always be the second car to arrive at the finish line...if he arrives at all. Smoother is faster.

6. What is the difference between a 4-wheel drift and an uncontrolled sliding skid?

About \$1,400 in car repairs and a couple days in the hospital.

7. Where is the best place around the course to watch the races?

One of the best things about watching a road race is that there are so many different kinds of racing to watch. Move around. Watch a slow corner for a while to start. This way you'll be able to study the various ways drivers brake, shift and accelerate-then move over to a high-speed corner. Things will be happening faster here, but look for the same things taking place. You see some drivers attempt to pass going into corners while others wait until they are through the turn. Many people move all over the spectator area during a day of racing. Try it.

8. I have seen two identical cars race several times. One car is red. The other blue, but the red car always wins, How come?


Perhaps the blue car has a yellow driver and a green mechanic.

9. Occasionally I've seen men standing near a turn holding or waving a yellow flag. Why are they there?

Safety. They let the drivers know of danger ahead. When the flag is being waved, it usually means there's an accident ahead or perhaps a car has spun out and is stalled on the road. A stationary yellow flag usually indicates less danger - a car pulled off the side of the road, etc.


10. How does a fella become a flagman?

He usually starts when his wife tells him he can't race anymore.



# VIEW FROM THE TOP

Welcome, race fans, to the revival of one of the greatest racing events in the Sports Car Club of America's broad spectrum of racing. What you will be watching this week end is the culmination of many months of hard work by the citizens of Garnett, Kansas; the Lake Garnett Racing Association; and the Kansas City Region of the Sports Car Club of America. The race course was re-inspected in June of this year, and broad safety requirements were made known to the Garnett Racing Association at that time. It involved thousands of dollars plus thousands of man hours of labor to meet the rather stringent safety requirements as set down by the club's safety inspection team.

The drivers you are watching this week end are part of over 5,400 licensed drivers in the Sports Car Club of America, competing not for money but national championship points. Their main objective will be the accumulation of these points; as the drivers who finish first, second and third in class will be invited to participate in the American Road Race of Champions at Road Atlanta, Thanksgiving week end. There they will meet winners of the other six racing divisions in our club, with the national championship at stake.

I find it difficult to believe myself that all of this started just twenty-eight years ago with seven people sitting around a New England pub. They had but one common interest---- an appreciation of fine automobiles. From that rather meager beginning in 1944 the Sports Car Club of America now boasts over 20,000 members that belong to one hundred and five separate Regions. We have members from every walk of life, some young and some old, both male and female, almost all of whom participate in some of the club's activities. Ours is not a racing club alone; for we also have a full program of national, divisional and club rallies, as well as full Solo program, in addition to our many-faceted racing program. Anyone interested in joining SCCA should fill out the membership application card in this program.

For those of you who may not be aware, the CanAm Series, the TransAm Series (both under and over 2.5 liters), the Continental and Pro Super Vee Championships are all SCCA-sanctioned events. These professional racing events will pay in excess of two million dollars in prize money in 1972.

One thing you'll be seeing new is the addition this year of eighteen-year-olds being allowed to race, with parental permission. Most other racing organizations have allowed this for the past few years, and - since adopted this year by SCCA - it has added two hundred drivers to our everincreasing rolls.

The only other phase of Garnett of which I'd like to make you aware is the overwhelming number of people it takes to put on this race for you. Those of you spectators who are near a corner crew will see that it takes five to seven people to man a corner, plus medical crews. Also, there must be fire-fighting equipment, wreckers, ambulances—and that does not include the multitudes of people and things necessary to get a race functioning smoothly. Some of the figures, just to give you an idea, are —— 300 corner workers, 200 drivers, 50-75 officials, 600 crew members, 100 additional workers not associated with the club——wrecker crews, etc. These, of course, are on the club side only. This list does not include concessionaries, ticket sellers, program sellers, gate guards, the many


Police who come to help----and on and on and on. This is not an easy project, which is the reason there are not more events of this kind.

I started racing in 1960 and my greatest desire was to race and win the Lake Garnett Grand Prix. My first race car was a Sprite and I came in fourth at the 1960 Garnett July 4th spectacular. For a variety of reasons I did not make it to the winners circle at Garnett until 1968 and the trophy I won here still hangs in a favorite spot.

I am now racing a red-white-and-blue Datsun two-liter. Those of you who are so inclined, please feel free to let me know how much you appreciate all the time and effort that have gone into making this show the most outstanding in the Midwest Division. My congratulations and thanks to the multitudes who have made it possible---not only for me to race here, but for you to see one of the greatest shows on earth. 




Contrary to some thinking, the people of the Garnett area have come to respect Lake Garnett as a valuable asset for their city.

Garnett is a nice place to live and work, too. Built on high ground that never floods, the city is surrounded by a rich farming area and a wealth of minerals; gas, oil, limestone, clay and shale for bricks and tile. Add to this all the up-to-date business, plus a fine hospital and high-type professional services, makes Garnett a nice place not only to visit, but to live.

Several years ago the Garnett Industrial Corporation was formed to help new industries find suitable sites and help with financing and other problems which arise when starting up a new business. Add to this attractive sites, reasonably priced utilities, a plentiful water supply, a good labor potential with the absence of "labor trouble" and sound economic conditions, excellent highways and rail connections, plus large parks, a football stadium, baseball diamonds, shelter houses and picnic facilities, a local airport and fine schools, and it makes Garnett a nice place to settle.

The races are put on each year by the Lake Garnett Racing Association, Inc., a non-profit corporation which uses all funds above expenses to improve both city parks. This year alone over \$40,000 was spent to re-finish and seal the main road racing service, add protection barriers for your safety, and increase the number of conession stands and rest room facilities to make this a most enjoyable week end. Plans to continue improving the track for spectator and racer alike are on the drawing board for the years ahead.

# SIGNALS IN RACING

# Racing Flags Have **Important** Meanings

#### GREEN

The race is on. The course is clear and drivers may proceed at full speed.

#### YELLOW - MOTIONLESS

Caution, danger ahead. No passing until past danger area.

#### YELLOW - WAVING

Use extreme caution and be prepared to stop. No passing until past danger area.

Stop immediately. Clear the track as well as possible.

#### BLUE - MOTIONLESS

Another car is following you closely.

#### BLUE - WAVING

Move over to allow a faster car to pass.

#### YELLOW WITH VERTICAL RED STRIPES Debre or oil on the track. Use Caution.

#### WHITE

An ambulance or other service vehicle is on the track. Use caution.

#### BLACK

Complete the lap, then come into pits for consultation.

#### BLACK - FURLED

Warning for unsafe or improper driving. If continued, driver will be called into pits.

#### BLACK WITH ORANGE BALL IN CENTER

Mechanical failure or other difficulties observed. Proceed to pits at reduced speed.

#### CHECKERED

Race ended. Complete one more lap at reduced speed, then enter pits.

# RULES FOR **SPECTATORS**

Your co-operation in making racing at Lake Garnett both safe and enjoyable for everyone concerned will be greatly appreciated. Please help us by carefully reading and observing the following rules:

- 1. Stand behind the fences they have been placed where they are for your safety.
- 2. Never stand on the outside of any curve.
- 3. Never stand in escape areas or roads these are safety valves for out-of-control cars.
- 4. Never interfer with officials, flagmen, or guards these men are working for your enjoyment and safety.
- 5. Never run toward an accident.
- 6. Never permit a child or a dog to wander unattended. Keep an eye on your children!
- Never approach an overturned or disabled car.
- 8. Never drop newspapers or any other objects on or near the course - papers can fall across a windshield, blinding a driver; stones and bottles can be snapped back like bullets.

# **Camping Prohibited**

Both the North and South Lakes at Garnett will be closed Friday and Saturday nights, except to members of the Kansas City Region of the Sports Car Club of America. No camping will be allowed except by the drivers and their crews and only in designated areas.

Garnett Jaycees have an available camp ground three miles southeast of Garnett. Look for signs.

#### ORDINANCE NO. 1879. CITY OF GARNETT

The construction and erection of temporary structures, scaffolds, platforms, or perches, either stationary or moveable, on or off a vehicle, on public grounds of the City of Garnett, Kansas, is prohibited except by permission of the proper authorities.

Violators of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor.
